PARTICIPATED ON THE TEXAS WARRANT ROUND UP. THE AMNESTY PERIOD WAS FROM FEBRUARY 14TH-25TH. IT WAS SUCCESSFUL. THE PEOPLE TOOK ADVANTAGE OF COMING IN AND TAKING CARE OF THEIR PENDING WARRANTS WITHOUT GETTING ARRESTED. THE WARRANT ROUND UP WAS MARCH 26TH-MARCH 5TH. THE POLICE OFFICERS MADE SOME ARRESTS BUT IT WAS NOT TOO SUCCESSFUL DUE TO THE DEFENDANTS NOT HAVING A GOOD ADDRESS AND NOT LIVING AT THE ADDRESS PROVIDED ON THE DRIVER'S LICENSE.

THE JUDGE WILL NOT MAGISTRATE AT THIS TIME DUE TO ALL THE CHANGES OF SENATE BILL 6. THERE WILL BE REPORTS REQUIRED BY THE OFFICE OF COURT ADMINISTRATION. ALL INMATES WILL BE SENT STRAIGHT TO THEIR DESIGNATED COUNTY.

THE JUDGE WILL CONTINUE MAGISTRATING ON LOCAL WARRANTS AND CAPIAS PRO FINES. THE JUDGE WILL CONTINUE SIGNING CLASS A, B MISDEMEANORS AND FELONIES. THE JUDGE WILL STILL CONTINUE IN ISSUING EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE ORDERS.
